1. Playability

- Neck is straight (check by sighting down the neck)
- Action (string height) is comfortable (not too high or too low)
- No fret buzz across the neck
- Frets are smooth with no sharp ends
- **Intonation is accurate** (12th fret harmonic = 12th fret note)
- Neck feels good in your hand (comfortable profile and width)

2. Structural Condition

- **No cracks** in the body, neck, or headstock
- **Bridge is secure** (not lifting on acoustics)
- **Neck joint is solid** (no gaps or movement)
- No signs of major repairs (unless professionally done)

✓ 3. Sound Quality

- Clear tone across all strings
- Good sustain when notes or chords ring out
- **No buzzing or rattling** sounds
- Even volume across strings

For electrics:

- **Tested plugged in** (no buzzing or dead pickups)
- **Pickups sound good** (bridge/middle/neck tones)

🗸 4. Hardware & Electronics

- Tuning pegs work smoothly and hold pitch
- Nut and saddle are properly cut (no string binding)
- Bridge is secure and adjusted properly
- Knobs and switches are noise-free
- Output jack is solid (no crackling when cable moves)

√ 5. Comfort & Fit

- **Body size feels right** (not too bulky or small)
- Neck is easy to play up and down the fretboard
- Overall weight is comfortable
- Visually appealing and inspiring to play

6. Extras (Optional but Helpful)

- Comes with a case or gig bag
- Strap buttons secure
- **Includes accessories** (strap, tuner, picks, etc.)
